

CTiK Day of Prayer 2026

Saturday 10 October: 6am-6pm

CTiK will be holding its annual time of prayer for Keswick and the surrounding villages on Saturday 10 October 6am-6pm in the Crosthwaite Sunday School room. This falls within the National Week of Prayer and so that we can be part of that – for further details of that [click here](#). Those who have taken part in previous years have commented how special it is to spend an hour alone with God, and how quickly the time seems to go. Please don't think this is not for you!

Over the course of the day there are 12 one hour long slots and individuals or groups of folk from the Christian community in Keswick and surrounding area are encouraged to sign up for a one hour slot to pray in the Sunday School room, with the aim of filling all the slots between us all (please see attached). Feel free to sign up as an individual, as a pair, or as a larger group. It doesn't matter if there is one or ten people signed up for a particular hour.

This year we will again be offering a prayer lunch in the 12noon-1pm slot. Can I invite you to bring your lunch along at 12 noon - drinks will be provided - and we can eat together and then spend some together praying for our community and our nation until 1pm.

On the day there will be some resources and suggestions of topics to pray for, but don't feel constrained by that for the scope of your prayers as there are plenty of needs in our community, country and the world.
