The Two's Company Keswick Befriending scheme continues to grow and is now well established in Keswick and the wider CA12 community. At the recent AGM and public meeting, those present were reminded that the aim of the scheme is to reduce social isolation and loneliness in this area and heard how the last four months have been an extremely busy period. There have been over 20 new referrals in this time and despite the active volunteer recruitment campaign that is in place there is now a waiting list for scheme members to be matched. Referrals have come not only from the Castlehead Medical Centre, other healthcare professionals and adult social care; but increasingly from family members and individuals referring themselves. There have been as many referrals matched to a befriender in the last three months than in the whole of last year; and as many volunteers recruited in the last three months than in the whole of last year.

We are very grateful to the Cumbria Community Foundation who not only have been the main funder for the first two years of the scheme but have now agreed to fund the majority of the running costs for the next three years as well. This is great news and the support of them has been absolutely invaluable and gives us a stable platform on which to grow further and develop.

We remain very grateful to our growing number of befriending volunteers, but not surprisingly we have a pressing need for an ongoing supply of new volunteer befrienders to meet the everincreasing number of referrals.

We are looking for volunteers who can offer an hour a week, are interested in people, good at listening and want to make a difference. We provide the required training and support - and most importantly befriending makes a huge difference to those who are visited. Thank you! As well as one-to-one befriending, we are running a monthly Activity Afternoon for Scheme Members and their Befrienders, and other residents of Greta Gardens (where the afternoons are held) who may well access our befriending scheme at some point in the future. We organize crafts, puzzles, quizzes, games and provide tea and coffee and cake and biscuits, which goes down very well with everyone!
